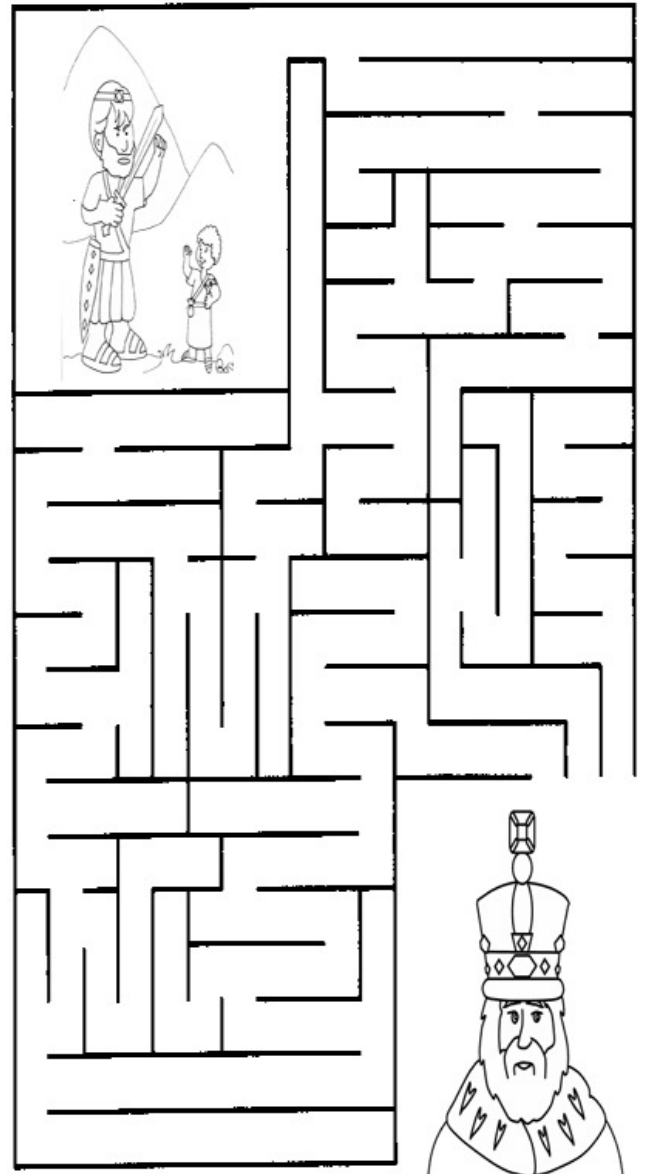
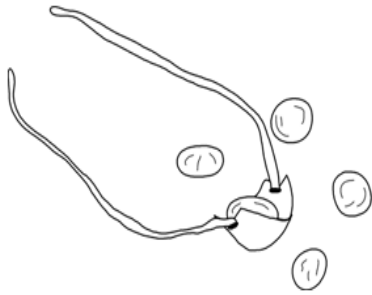


Verse to Remember
